

DIOCESAN/ST. PIUS X UNIFIED PASTORAL PLAN (UPP) IMPLEMENTATION/ACTION PLAN

FEBRUARY/MARCH/APRIL

Note: Because of the variation in meeting dates, the implementation of the plan will vary throughout this first phase while the plan is being introduced and when specific action items are selected.

1. Staff, Councils, School Board should:

- Place the Implementation/Action Plan on their agendas and maintain it there as a regular agenda item.
- Distribute the UPP and the Implementation/Action Plan to all members.
- Familiarize themselves with the UPP and the action plan. Both are posted on the parish website.
- Each group should select an aim and work on it together. See item 3 below for ideas.
- Develop an action plan.
- Liaisons to the Pastoral Council should include updates/progress in their monthly written reports.

2. Commissions should:

- Place the Implementation/Action Plan on each of their agendas and maintain it there as a regular agenda item.
- Distribute the UPP and the Implementation/Action Plan to all ministry chairs via e-mail, where possible. In case there is a chair who doesn't use e-mail, contact that individual directly and provide a hard copy. Both the UPP and the implementation plan are posted on the parish website.
- Inform ministry chairs about the Plan (UPP) and the implementation plan.
- If your commission doesn't meet monthly or already has met for the month of February, contact each ministry chair to urge each one to add the Plan to its agenda and to begin a discussion about developing an action plan.

3. Ministries

- Each ministry should familiarize itself with the UPP and the implementation plan. Then,
- Based on the Plan, what can be done in your ministry that is going to bring people back to their faith?
- How might a different approach or renewed emphasis affect the mission of your ministry?
- Is there a ministry within your commission/board that is struggling to meet its goals/mission, or has it completely stalled? What can be done to reinvigorate it?
- Place the Implementation/Action Plan on its agenda and maintain it there as a regular agenda item for the remainder of the year.
- Report and discuss progress at each succeeding Commission meeting.

4. Commissions should:

- Select an area on which to focus its attention. It doesn't have to be a major action.
- Develop an action plan.
- Report progress at each succeeding Pastoral Council meeting

MAY
